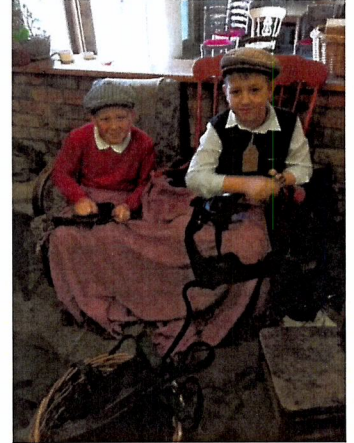




Dear Parents and Carers,

Attendance if any families need support around attendance Mrs Allen (Inclusion lead) is happy to help with any worries, please contact school if you need any advice or help.

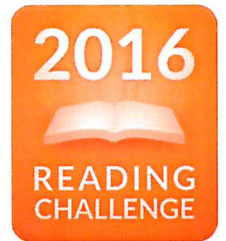
Reading For Life:
