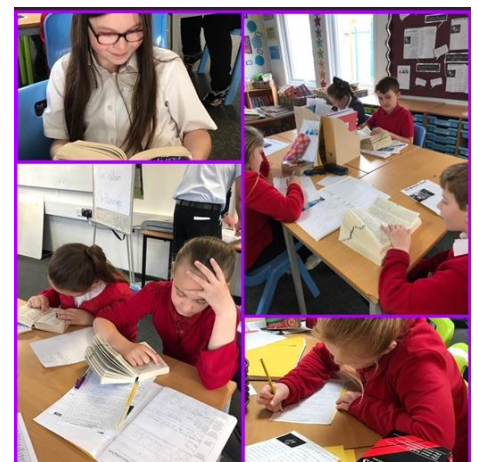
Please remember school is closed for Bank Holiday on Monday 7<sup>th</sup> May, we re-open on Tuesday.
