So far we have participated in Athletics, Multi Skills and football and are due to participate in Basketball, Rounders. Play ground leader training (Allowing year 5 children to lead games at playtime to make playtimes more active for the younger children in school – This happens 4 times a week with KS1) 6 team teach sessions allowing for improvement of quality of teaching. (Already this year the team teach sessions have shown improved confidence and quality of teaching with new staff and NQTS in school)
