Parent, Carer and Visitor Code of Conduct

At Sheep Dip Lane Primary School we have supportive and friendly parents/carers, who recognise that educating children involves partnership between home and school. For these reasons we welcome and encourage parents/carers to participate fully in the life of our school.

The purpose of this guidance is to provide a reminder to all parents, carers, visitors to our school about expected conduct so that we can work together to ensure a safe and positive school environment for our children.

RESPECT AND CONCERN FOR OTHERS AND THEIR RIGHTS

We treat all parents/carers with respect and we feel this needs to be mutual to ensure the best outcomes for the children. This includes:

- Parents/carers setting a positive example for their children.
- Working together with teachers for the benefit of children, i.e. supporting home learning and approaching school to resolve any issues of concern appropriately to ensure we can bring about a positive solution.
- We ask parents/carers to reinforce the schools positive behaviour policy.
- Respecting school property.

IN ORDER TO SUPPORT A POSITIVE AND SAFE SCHOOL ENVIRONMENT, THE SCHOOL DOES NOT TOLERATE:

- The use of loud and/or offensive language or displaying behaviour which can be perceived as aggressive
- Threatening harm or the use of physical aggression towards another adult or child.
- Damaging school property.
- Abusive, threatening and/or malicious emails, phone calls or social network messages.
- Smoking on site or being under the influence of alcohol or any other substance will not be tolerated.

Inappropriate behaviour on school premises or towards staff will be reported to the appropriate authorities and Governors may prohibit adults from entering the school grounds to safeguard our school community.

POSITIVE SUPPORT FOR OUR SCHOOL

Sheep Dip Lane Primary School considers the use of social media websites being used inappropriately as unacceptable and not in the best interests of the children or the whole school community. Any concerns you may have must be reported to Class Teacher; Inclusion Manager (if appropriate); or the Headteacher, so they can be dealt with fairly, appropriately and effectively for all concerned.

Any pupil or parent/carer of a child being educated at Sheep Dip Lane Primary School who is found to be posting rude or disrespectful comments on Facebook or other social network sites, will be reported to the appropriate 'report abuse' section of the network site. The school will also expect that any parent/carer or pupil removes such comments immediately.

In serious cases and under the Malicious Communications Act 1988, the Police will be informed and the school will consider its legal options to deal with any such misuse of social networking and other sites.
