General notes on the data

This report uses the data that was available on 1 August 2023. Figures for the school, LA and national may change following checking and validation, and the figures given here may therefore differ from the final data published by DfE and in ASP (Analyse School Performance).

For the 2023 report, trend charts are limited to just 2 years, because schools did not complete an EYFSP in 2021 because of Covid. With significant changes to the framework, including the removal of the "exceeding (3)" grade and the revision and reconfiguration of the areas of learning and the early learning goals, it is not possible to provide a meaningful comparison with previous years.
