Know that they can use paint and drawing to record what they see.

Know that if they add water to paint is becomes runny.

Know how to draw some marks: linear, circular and wavy to create an image and pattern.

Know how to mix powder paint using a number 20 brush.

Know how to mix thick paint.


Know if they add white to blue it makes pale blue.

Recording from observation of first hand experiences wavy patterns in powder paint, mixing shades of blue by adding white. Wavy and line dabbing. Water effect.



Observe and record ripples in water, drips into puddles, colour in water tray shades of blue in the environment, artist images

Observe, record ripples using white wax crayon and then a blue paint wash. Practice circular drawing marks.



Wax resist
