Homework

Children will be set three pieces of homework a week on Seesaw. There will be a math, literacy/spelling and a topic piece set. The homework will be set on Seesaw on a Friday and will need to be completed before the start of school on the following Friday.

Reading

Children are expected to bring in their reading book every day and change their book when needed. Please make sure reading is logged on our online platform- 'Learning with parents' Children are expected to read a minimum of five times each week at home in Year 6. For every 50 reads they achieve this year, they will visit our book shop and choose a book to take home. We aim to listen to each child at least once a week in school and if needing more support, they will be heard daily. Shared reading, independent reading, story time and reading to a buddy are all opportunities where we can enjoy reading. Our class novel is called 'My Friend Walter.'
