Welcome to Foundation Stage 2

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We have lots of staff in FS to help you with your learning. Mrs Matthews is your class teacher. We also have Mrs Mason who is in our class full time and Mrs Cook who also supports us in class throughout the week on an afternoon. Mrs Bateman also supports FS2 during Thursday and Friday afternoons.



Home Reading

Your child will bring home a new reading book linked to our reading scheme Little Wandle. This is a book they will practise in school 3 times before bringing it home on a Friday. This needs to be brought back to school every day so that children can read in our reading café session.

This year, it is expected that all children will read at home 3 times a week to support their learning in school.

This really helps their progress and gives them more practise with their phonics skills.



Our Topic

In Spring Term 1 our topic is 'People who help us.' We will be looking at different roles and occupations as well as the emergency services. Children will be learning about different roles and responsibilities for different occupations and how they help us.

In Spring term 2 out topic will be 'Minibeasts." In this topic the children will look at different minibeasts and where they live. We will be making our own minibeasts homes and going on minibeasts hunts in our Forest School.

Tapestry

Tapestry is our online journal where you can see what your child has been learning each week. Staff working in the FS unit will upload photos of your children during their learning time.

We will also use tapestry to upload home learning, letters and key dates. Please remember to check it regularly for events and information.

Reading Café Mornings

Please remember that every Friday morning between 8:30-8:50 one parent/ carer is welcome to come into school to complete children morning tasks and read stories together. This is also a get opportunity for children to get another read of their reading books in for their 3 times a week weekly reads.
